## Council Amendment No. 1 Ordinance No. 2014-108s Green

I recommend the following amendments to the proposal in order to require that the Pierce County airports at Thun Field and Tacoma Narrows allow public access on weekdays between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.:

1. At page 8 of Exhibit B, beginning at line 17, insert text as follows:

“Access Gates, Hangar/Building Security, and Locks:

- Airport access gates shall be open to public entry on weekdays between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Outside of these times and days, access gates shall be secure access only and access shall be by use of an access code or card.
- Persons who have been provided either a code or device for the purpose of obtaining access to the Airport shall abide by the written agreement and procedures in effect for the use of a code or device. In addition, all such persons shall only use Airport-issued codes/devices and shall not divulge, duplicate, or otherwise distribute the same to any other person, unless approved by the Administrator.
- Entering the Airport through a controlled access gate must be done one vehicle at a time. No entry tailgating or piggybacking behind another entering vehicle.
- Tampering with, interfering with, or disabling the lock, or closing mechanism or breaching any other securing device at the Airport is prohibited.
- The Director or designee shall have the authority to implement additional access restrictions on a temporary basis when necessary for special events, emergencies, or similar unique circumstances; provided that any such restrictions which would exceed 30 days in duration must be approved by the Council.”
